Art Competition

1. Objective and theme:

The aim of the Art Competition is to engage and further motivate our ODISSeA community through a ludic, artistic activity.

In this regard we are delighted to invite ODISSeA’s team, learners and trainers alike, **to express through ART what ODISSeA means to them, and inspire us all through their creativity.**

2. Art Formats

The competition is open to ALL art forms (music, painting, photography, writing, drawing, singing, etc.). Originality of the expression will be valued during the selection process.

3. Length

Wherever it applies, please ensure that length of artwork does not exceed 2 minutes for audio-visual or half a page for written form.

4. Working language

Wherever the art piece employs oral or written language, please ensure that **one** of the following options is considered:

- Creation directly in English
- OR
- Local language with English translation provided

5. The Entry Process:

- o **Step 1.** Choose the art form that suits you best
- o **Step 2.** Develop the art piece
- o **Step 3.** Submit your art piece to coordination@odisseaproject.eu within the deadline stipulated. Please mention in your e-mail your name, university you represent and country.



6. Selection, evaluation and rewarding process:

- **PHASE 1: EVALUATION AND PRE-SELECTION.** The faculty of each Southeast Asian (SeA) university will be assigned to evaluate the artwork of their colleagues (project team, trainers and learners alike) from another country. The faculty will select best 3 art pieces, according to the selection criteria stipulated below.
- **PHASE 2: FINAL SELECTION.** The art pieces selected will be shared on the ODISSeA social media channels for voting.
- **PHASE 3: REWARDING.** Different prizes will be awarded to the most voted artworks.

7. Selection Criteria

Art pieces will be evaluated from 1-very poor; 2-poor; 3-average; 4-good; to 5-very good, on each of the items listed below:

- Suitability to the theme proposed
- Originality of the art piece
- Skill and technique
- Inherent meaning

8. Submission

Only one submission will be accepted per individual. The artwork is an individual contribution and group works are not accepted to facilitate its evaluation and rewarding. If the creation of the art piece requires the involvement of other subjects, that is accepted. However, only the submitting author will be evaluated and possibly rewarded.

9. Deadlines

Artworks shall be submitted by July 15th, 2020. Late submissions will not be accepted. Evaluation will be concluded, and winners notified by August 10th, 2020.

10. Copy rights

By joining this art competition, you grant us the non-exclusive right to disseminate your artwork in the ODISSeA dissemination channels. Artworks will not be used for any other purpose than that which is stated here. The list of winners will be displayed on the ODISSeA website and social media channels until project closure.
